notice：if you know someone with a Macintosh who needs an external disk dive，note that a regular 512K Mac or any 128K Mac cannot use Apple＇s new 800K dive－these machines must use 400 K drives．If you need a 400 K dive，used

通ifnon－Local Gossip Finally：Sept．brought the formal introduction of the Apple IIGS－＂graphics and sound＂－which is actually the longrumored Ilx in disguise．Using a 16 －bit 65 C 816 running at 2.8 MHz ，it is three times faster than a lle，and is $90 \%$ compatible with current Apple software．Base price for the machine is $\$ 999$ for 256K RAM（expandable to 8 Mb ），and 128K ROM（which includes QuickDraw routines，ala Macintosh），and a full system will run $\$ 1800$ ．It supports ProDos 16，ProDos 8，CP／M， Pascal，and DOS 3．3．

Gone is Ile beige and IIc white，replaced by a new platinum color case．The IIGS has a detached keyboard with numeric keypad，and uses a 15 －voice Ensoniq 32 synthesizer chip with 64K RAM dedicated to sound．He machines can get a GS upgrade in early 1987 for $\$ 499$ ．IIGS $3.5^{\prime \prime}$ disk dives and SCSI hard disks are interchangable with the Macintosh，but they can＇t read each other＇s files．
Qpple also has announced an SCSI card for the Apple II line for $\$ 129$ ，plus a 256 K memory expansion card for the IIc that can be expanded to 1 Mb ．In yet another announcement，Apple lowered the price of a Macintosh Enhanced to $\$ 1,699$（from \＄1，999）and a Macintosh Plus to $\$ 2,199$（from \＄2，599）．The LaserWriter was also dopped to \＄4，999 from \＄5，999．
near Apple：Franklin＇s 2100，an Apple clone，

is being sold in the Sears FallWinter catalog for $\$ 799.99$, including built-in disk drive and 384 K RAM. Franklin is also marketing (but not through Seers) an IBM PC clone, the PC- 8000 , with two floppy dives and 512K RAM, for $\$ 999$.
Oshton-Tate has released dBASE Mac, a greatly enhanced version of dBASE III Plus which can read and write IBM PC dBASE files (all ya gotta do is fold up the 5.25" diskettes and put them in the $3.5^{\prime \prime}$ drives). dBASE Mac, however, supports pull-down menus, can store picture files, can have individual records up to 32 K in length (and unlimited file length), can have up to 36 files linked together, etc.

What is really nice, though, is the method of linking: instead of complex indexes and such, all a user has to do is draw a line from one field in one file to another field in another file. dBASE Mac does not support local area networks but, according to most reports, the IBM PC networking version of dBASE III doesn't work with networks, either.
C9D: InfoWorld had a review of CAD (Computer Aided Design) software in the Aug. 11 issue. Of the 19 packages reviewed, 5 were for the Mac and 14 for the IBM. Of most interest were the prices: Mac software ranged from $\$ 39.95$ to $\$ 995$ ( $\$ 200$ average), while the IBM software ran from $\$ 99.95$ to $\$ 2995$ ( $\$ 1500$ average). None of the Mac software required any extra equipment beyond a printer or plotter, while all the IBM software required tons of optional graphics cards, monitors, extra memory, etc. As there are also several inexpensive Atari ST and Amiga CAD packages out now, it doesn't look like a good time to invest in CAD software for the IBM.
[Antic, for example, has CAD-3D, a $\$ 49.95$ package for the Atari ST, which can be used with special $\$ 160$ glasses to give "true" on-screen 3D images.]
Just cohen you thought they couldn't: Commodore reported $\$ 1.2$ million in profit for the quarter ending June 30 , their first time in the black since 1984. With this boost, Commodore's losses for the past year were just $\$ 127.9$ million, or a dollar lost for every seven in income, easily eclipsing the previous year's losses of $\$ 113.9$ million. Considering their haphazard marketing of the Amiga, the company's most interesting product, Commodore may try for even greater
losses in 1987, or they might try for larger profits $\$ 1.3$ million, anyone?

investigators are looking at Commodore's advertieing claims that the Amiga is IBM PC compatible. According to compaints (almost all from dealers), "only 20 or so" IBM programs work on the Amiga using the software emulation program and $5.25^{\prime \prime}$ disk dive, and even then the programs are six times slower than on an IBM PC.
Dishette Gazette, published by International Datawares, rates black-case Memorex 3.5 inch diskettes (used by Macs, Amigas, etc.) as about the worst available, and Sony diskettes as the best. These conclusions are widely supported by local users, who almost universally condemn the black-case diskettes as being prone to crashes. If you've had problems, you might want to write to the following address, asking for an exchange. The editor recently sent 45 bad Memorex diskettes, and got 55 new (and, $s 0$ far, good) diskettes by return mail. The new diskettes, by the way, have a blue case.

Eagle Computer Inc. has liquidated. The company had a string of bad luck, starting with the death of the company founder in an auto wreck on the day Eagle had its first public stock offering. Eagle found it couldn't make IBM PC clones as cheaply as others, and didn't have any great technology to offer, so it - vanished.
Conroy-Lapointe, infamous mail order firm (infamous to dealers, at least), has filed for Chap. 11.
Uncle Sam bought 67,500 microcomputers in 1985, almost double the number purchased in 1984 and a huge jump from the 7,900 purchased in 1983. GSA, after auditing several micro sites,
concluded the micros not only increased productivity, they also increased the quality of work performed, and greatly increased the timeliness of work.

During 1985 Zenith sold 15,406 micros to the govt. ( $\$ 42.8$ million, averaging $\$ 2,778$ per machine), while IBM sold 13,567 micros (\$47.8 million, averaging $\$ 3,523$ per machine).
Rear 9dm. Grace Murray Hopper was allegedly retired in August because of GrammRudman. According to the official Navy line, America's oldest service member was retired to free up billets for sea duty. Strangely enough, virtually no one seems to believe this - exactly how does a 79 year old female admiral and computer and mathmatics genius hinder manning of sea billets?

Her 43 years service with the Navy doesn't quite match the record of the late Adm. Rickover, but like Rickover she is known for her willingness to be controversial and her undeniable brilliance. She is generally recognized as the world's first programmer, wrote the first compiler, wrote the first progam to write programs, and is credited with inventing COBOL. Most recently, she has been touring the country, advising Navy personnel on data automation projects and lecturing on efficient use of computers. Her retirement, on Aug. 14, took place aboard the USS Constitution in Boston harbor.
Coant a real IBM PC? They're cheaper now: a two dive, 256 K machine is $\$ 1595$, a one ctive, 256K machine is $\$ 1445$, and a 64 K , no drive machine is $\$ 1165$. Ah, for the good old days, when a 64K IBM with no dives, no monitor, no printer port, no serial port, but with a genuine IBM cassette port was just a cool $\$ 2195$.
True: Big Blue, trying to kill off the clones, is attempting to patent the PC-AT keyboard and case.
True: IBM has sent threatening letters to several clone makers which use the letters "AT" in their product names.
Probably not True: IBM is trying to get a copyright on the entire alphabet to eliminate people from unauthorized use of "PC," "XT," "AT," "ABCDE," etc.
Long delays for IBM's laptop, the Convertible, were not caused by defects, by the dumb design, or by a shortage of the non-Hayes compatible modem, but by "overwhelming
demand," claims IBM. Exactly why anyone would want a not-very-powerful, not-very-small, incompatible version of an IBM PC is not clear, but IBM claims there are many such people out there, somewhere.
microsoft, Intel, and several other manufacturers have come out with a series of software and hardware products which allows Microsoft Windows to look as crisp, and respond as quickly, as a Macintosh. The first requirement is an IBM PC-AT ( $\$ 3500-6000$ ), to which you add less than $\$ 2500$ in optional software and hardware. So, for just $\$ 6000-8500$, you can have a computer that works almost like a $\$ 1495$ Macintosh. Isn't science wonderful?

On the serious side, the demand for the $\$ 2500$ Windows hardware and software is so great that supplies are on allocation. It appears there are some people in the world with entirely too much money on their hands
Clone coars should get even hotter now that Hyundai, the Korean auto and ship builder, has started selling the Blue Chip in the U.S. Priced at $\$ 699$, the Blue Chip is fully IBM PC compatible, and comes with 512K RAM, one disk dive, and MSDOS. It probably gets good gas mileage, too. Lotus has finally decided to remove copy protection from 1-2-3 - but only for large corporate customers buying at least 100 copies. In a similar effort, Lotus will sell a non-copy protected version of 1-2-3 to the U.S. government through Technical Services, Inc. Unfortunately for Lotus, this comes after DOD selected Supercalc for the new Zenith contract - and virtually everyone who has tried Supercalc thinks it is better than 1-2-3.
กОЯด (National Oceanic and Atmospheric Admin.) and the Army have issued requests for procurement of a portable computer compatible with the Macintosh.
Many small newspapers have switched over from multi-million dollar composing machines to Macintosh computers using page layout software. Even some big names have switched over, at least partially, including USA Today, The New York Times Co., New York News, Inc., MacMillan Publishing, and Doubleday. Unfortunately, the Seahawk and Pacific Stars \& Stripes are not among this group.
Unisource Softcoare has released "Feima," a $\$ 95$ Chinese word processor for the

Macintosh. Even the drop-down menus are in Chinese - no English is required.
Don't coant anyone to find out you're playing Flight Simulator on your Mac during duty time? Falcon Microsystems ( 1801 McCormick Dr., Landover, MD 20785) has released a $\$ 5945$ TEMPEST certified Macintosh and $\$ 3400$ Imagewriter-compatible TEMPEST printer. Falcon will also retrofit existing Fat Macs to meet TEMPEST standerds for $\$ 4350$.

Falcon's TEMPEST Mac comes with 512K RAM and two internal disk dives. The extra disk dive, combined with the TEMPEST shielding, bumps the weight from 17 pounds to 26 pounds. If you don't know what TEMPEST is, here's a hint: it has nothing to do with Shakespeare.
Enzanhoshigumi Co. (it looks better in kanji) has released two disks worth of Japanese clip art for the Macintosh - really nice stuff, but expensive. But what's really interesting is their plan for a new ink-brush package for the Mac, which offers a menu listing such choices as "Fude-size," "Sumi," and "Washi." If anyone has this, contact the editor!!
microsoft CDorks, a Macintosh version of Appleworks, is out now for $\$ 295$. While it isn't as powerful as Word or Excel, almost everyone agrees it is "pretty slick," and just the thing for computer novices. Release of Works is rumored to have pushed back the release of Microsoft Word 2.0 for the Mac.
next, Inc., Steve Job's new outfit, bought Solaster Corp. to get hold of their new Macintosh word processor. Now Next has sold marketing rights to the package to T/Maker. Right-Now, as the package is called, will be out in Oct. for $\$ 175$. What next?
not everyone at NASA can use their new Cray-2 (a modest machine with just 256 million words [16 billion 8-bit bytes] of memory), so some researchers are using the Prodigy 4. The Prodigy 4 is essentially your everyday Mac Plus, but with a $16 \mathrm{MHz} 68020 \mathrm{CPU}, 68881$ math coprocessor, and 4 megabytes of RAM, all for just $\$ 7000$. For those who don't need quite this much horsepower, there is the Turbo Amiga for $\$ 5,765$, with a 10 MHz 68020,68881 , and just 2 megabytes of RAM.
For their 1986 fiscal year, ending June 30, Tandy repored $\$ 3$ billion in total revenues, with earnings for the year of $\$ 197.7$ million. Profits
would have been even higher, but Tandy spent lots of money buying several companies and purchasing back a large chunk of its own stock.
Tandy has added four new PC-compatible computers, the 3000 HL with 512 K RAM, 80286 CPU, one floppy dive, and three slots, for $\$ 1699$; the 3000 HD , with 640 K RAM, one 1.2 megabyte floppy, a 40 megabyte hard disk, and 80286 CPU, for \$4299; the 1000SX, with two floppys, 384K RAM, and five slots, for $\$ 1199$; and the 1000 EX , with one floppy, 256K RAM, and three slots, for $\$ 799$. Tandy also announced the Color Computer 3 with 128K RAM and a 2 MHz 6809 CPU for $\$ 219.95$, making it by far the cheapest multi-user multi-tasking computer in the world.
CDang fans (keep the jokes to yourself, please) should rejoice at the new Wang laptop computer. Easily the ugliest laptop yet, the machine is designed to act as a portable terminal to a Wang VS network, and comes with a 10 Mb hard disk and built-in thermal printer. Priced at $\$ 3,500$, it can run only a few IBM PC programs under an emulation mode.
Olps Omerica shipped 25,000 P2000G printers to Zenith in July and August, all part of a contract worth up to $\$ 50$ million. The Alps printers are the first contract modification to the big Department of Defense contract with Zenith for up to 90,000 IBM PC-AT compatible machines and peripherals. Under the original contract, printers were to be supplied by MPI, which has a considerable reputation, but not necessarily a positive one.
InfocDorld, in an Aug. 4 review, gave the Zenith Z-200 very high marks in everything but price. As the DOD price is far less than the standard list price, this shouldn't bother anyone ordering a Z-248 for their work area. InfoWorld also reported users were having problems with Z-248 machines overheating. Follow-up reports suggest this may have been a false alarm.
Zenith Electronics lost $\$ 14.6$ million in the first six months of 1986. Significantly, the computer systems division increased sales by 19 percent, to $\$ 143$ million - losses appear to have come from other divisions.
